Waka Allocation

The Club has 10 waka; 5 x W6, 1 x W2,
1x W1. Rostered training times are on the
club website. Contact Waka Allocator to
book training, races, waka experience etc.

Equipment

Life jackets and plastic kayak paddles are
available for training sessions and stored
in shed. Wash and return to the shed after
use.

Keys

are issued to a designated team member
and give access to the shed and waka. A
\$20 bond is payable prior to issue. Keys
must be returned at the AGM or at the
request of the club executive.

**All waka must be padlocked when not
in use.**

Training Sessions - Be Prepared

- You should be reasonably fit with
good upper body mobility
- Footwear is not necessary
- Wear light unrestricting clothing -
wetsuit type clothing is recommended
during cold weather.
- Wear sunblock and a protective hat

There are a number of route teams can
choose eg:

- Pilot Bay to Matakana Island
- Pilot Bay to Harbour Bridge
- Pilot Bay - out the Entrance
- Paddling to Tauranga
- within the Harbour

IMPORTANT: let someone know
where you are paddling and an estimated
time of return.
